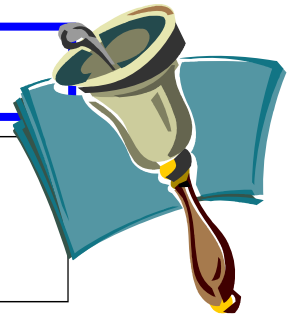


Hand Bell Ringing Club
