Important information for you to read before you fill in this form

If you receive one of these benefits you will be able to apply for free school meals and school clothing grants

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, but are **not entitled to Working Tax Credit** and your annual income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) is less than £16,040
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit

Your child should

- Be in full-time education and under 19 years of age to be able to get free school meals
- Be in full-time education and under compulsory school leaving age (16) to be able to get a school clothing grant
- And attend a Local Authority School or sixth form

Children who are due to leave school in the month of June will **not** be entitled to receive a clothing grant after the 30 April.

If your child attends a nursery school, a private school or a college, they will not get free school meals or school clothing grants,

- your Child Tax Credit Award letter
- a recent Income Support letter (less than 3 months old)
- a Job Seekers Allowance letter
- an Employment and Support Allowance letter
- a recent Post Office or bank statement (less than 1 month old)
- a Home Office letter

Please note that we are unable to accept "Signing on cards" as proof of benefit. **If you stop receiving any of the benefits mentioned above or you change your address**, you must inform the Education Social Work Service immediately
