**Classroom Management**

**Learning**

**Induction**



### How does it help our children?

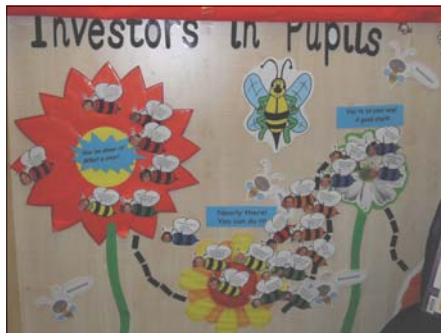
Investors in Pupils helps all our children in many ways.

It helps them to know:

- how they can contribute towards their own learning
- who helps them to learn
- the roles and responsibilities of everyone at Reinwood
- that they never stop learning
- why they need to come to school
- about finance and the school budget
- who our *Governors* are and what they do
- how to look after new people in school
- that they all learn in different ways
- the benefits of making good choices
- that they are an important part of their class/school

## What we need to do to be and Investors in Pupils school

- the children think of their own **Individual Targets** (group ones for Nursery) and work towards that target
- the children in every class decide what they want their class to be run like, rules that they can try to keep. Then they write their **Class Promise**
- every class decides on a **Class Target** every week and a treat that they would like for Golden Time. When they achieve the Class Target the children have 2 more minutes on their accumulator eg Spots on a Giraffe, Alien on planets, Astronaut up a Rocket etc)
- an **Induction book**. Some classes call it a Welcome Book, to help new people find out about the class and feel welcome and confident .



## SMART Targets are:

- S** - specific
- M** - measurable
- A** - achievable
- R** - realistic
- T** - timed
