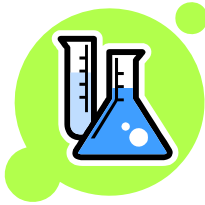

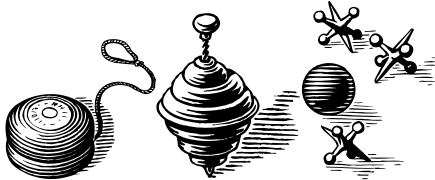


The **SCIENCE** learning morning organised by Mrs Ronson for the whole school proved very popular amongst children, staff and parents. Many thanks to all who were able to attend.

Hand to Mouth Puppets came to perform for the children in assembly this term. The theme for their performance was 'Daniel in the Lion's Den'

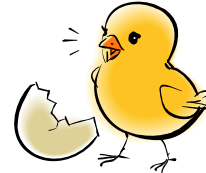


Dragon Mouth Puppets

There will be a café in the junior dining room following the morning performance only. Please send any donations of cakes and biscuits to the office on the morning of the 31st – thank you.



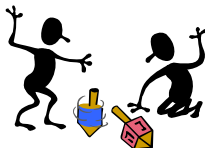
Easter Bonnet Competition
